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


LITTLE HANDS ON THE LAND

Little Hands on the Land teaches children the importance of agriculture and how it affects their daily lives in a fun and interactive way.

Children ages 2 to 10 become farmers at this free, hands-on exhibit. Children obtain a gathering basket and proceed along a path that includes a garden, apple orchard, chicken coop, grain shed, milking station and cattle farm. After gathering particular items along the way they get the chance to sell these items at the Little Hands on the Land Farmers' Market for a Little Hands dollar to spend at the Grocery Store.



1. GARDEN SHED

Armed with gardening tools, children plant vegetable seeds in one part of the garden, then harvest potatoes from another to sell at the Farmers' Market.

Plant some vegetable seeds to take home and collect a potato in your basket.

2. APPLE ORCHARD

Pick an apple either from the trees or off the ground and place the apple in your basket.

3. CHICKEN COOP

Grab an egg from the chickens to take with you.

4. GRAIN SHED

The local bakery needs flour and oats to make some delicious goodies. Mill the wheat and flake the oats, then collect your bag of oats and flour to sell at the Farmers' Market.

The animals need to be fed, take a bag of grain to feed and find the Miniature Hereford cattle.

5. MILKING STATION

Milk Bessie or one of her friends, then collect a milk carton for your basket.

6. CATTLE AND SHEEP FARM

Give the farmer the grain to feed the beef cattle. Be sure to look at the Shropshire sheep and the fleece on your way to the market.

7. FARMERS' MARKET

'Sell' the contents of your basket back at the Farmers Market and get a Little Hands dollar for all your hard work.

8. GROCERY STORE

Children can use their Little Hands dollar to buy something.
